



CONDITIONS FOR USE OF THE HCCSA PUBLIC ACCESS COMPUTER

This computer is provided for the use of members of the Hepatitis C Council of South Australia on the following conditions:

1. It is expected that users have the knowledge required to use the available software or to carry out their own internet searches. While staff members will provide support in accessing the computer system, we don't have the capacity to provide support in the use of the internet and other software on the system. Most metropolitan council libraries offer free basic computer classes.
2. This computer is provided primarily for accessing the internet for information. Any data stored by you on the C drive will be deleted.
3. Data can be transferred via USB flash drives. These are available at low cost at major stationery outlets.
4. You may not use this computer for any illegal activities.
5. You may not knowingly access any site dealing in pornographic material.
6. You may not use this computer to post, disseminate or communicate any obscene, lewd, violent, harassing, sexually explicit or otherwise objectionable subject matter.
7. You may not knowingly access sites promoting or condoning hate/discrimination against any person or groups of people because of their ethnicity, culture, gender, sexuality, nationality or religion.
8. You may not use it to incite hate or violence against any person or groups of people in our community.
